WHOSE CHILDREN MAY ATTEND?

The Center is open to the students, staff and faculty of the College as well as to the community.

CHILD ELIGIBILITY

1. Children aged 2 yrs 9 mo. to 5 years.
2. Children must be fully immunized and have a physician's clearance to participate.

FEES

State Preschool

The State Preschool (SP) program is FREE to families who qualify. This 3 hour program may be used in conjunction with full cost care when feasible.

Full Cost

For families that do not qualify for State Preschool, or who need additional time before or after SP. Current rates are available at the Center.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Complete and return an eligibility application.
2. Applicants applying for State Preschool (SP) must include documentation of income. Priority is given to children who are 4 years old.
3. Full cost applicants are prioritized according to application date.

☆ Parents may apply for both a subsidized and a full cost space. If applicant does not receive a subsidized space a full cost space will be offered until a space in SP becomes available.
