## WHAT IS THE BASIC FIRE ACADEMY?

A learning experience designed to provide students with entry level skills as a firefighter.

A very intensified training program that places heavy emphasis on personal safety through self-discipline and skills development.

The program satisfies those basic skills requirements that lead to certification as a Firefighter I with the State Fire Marshal's Office.

The Academy also offers an opportunity to work and train in a team work atmosphere. Teamwork is critical to adaptability as a firefighter.

## HOW WILL THE FIRE ACADEMY BENEFIT ME?

Presently, a majority of Fire Service Agencies require the completion of a Firefighter I Academy. The Academy curriculum provides this requirement.

## HOW DO I APPLY?

The successful Fire Academy applicant will have **COMPLETED** the following prerequisites:

1. Fire Technology 100 – Fire Service Organization (formerly Introduction to Fire Technology)
2. Fire Technology 101 – Fire Prevention Technology (formerly Fundamentals of Fire Prevention)
3. Possess a CURRENT EMT I card or completion certificate or Medical First Responder Card
4. Medical Clearance for Firefighters
5. Physical Agility – Successful completion of the Biddle or CPAT. Phone numbers in this packet.
6. Completion of the CHC English and Math Placement Test. Call 909-389-3267 for further information. Copy of degree taken in place of Placement Test.

You must attach proof of prerequisite completion to the application if you are to be accepted for enrollment. See enclosed application.

## **WHAT ARE THE FEES?**

Prerequisite classes cost an average of \$78.00 each plus books and additional college fees.

Academy fees are approximately \$950.00 plus any dues established by the Academy Class .

## **WHAT ARE THE FIRE ACADEMY CLASS SCHEDULES?**

Full-time Academy: 6:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday thru Friday for 12 weeks.

Pre-requisite Schedules are as follows:

1. EMS meets 8 hours per week (day or night) each semester for 18 weeks.
2. Fire Technology 100 and 101 meet 3 hours each week (day or evening) during the Fall and Spring semester for 18 weeks. These classes are also available during summer session.
3. The Biddle or CPAT must be current throughout academy attendance.

This is to certify that the above named individual is medically clear to participate in the following physical requirements of the Crafton Hills College Basic Firefighter Academy.

1. Cadence marching and drilling.
2. Lift objects weighing a minimum of 50 lbs. from the ground to a minimum of shoulder height.
3. Participate in a physical fitness program including cardiovascular efficiency and endurance exercise.
4. Participate in exercise and activities requiring eye-hand coordination, leg strength and coordination, grip strength, arm and upper body strength, shoulder strength and correct body weight distribution.
5. Maneuver, balance and climb ladders.
6. Lift, pull and maneuver charged and uncharged hose lines.
7. Perform in situations requiring the use of a self-contained breathing apparatus (standing and crawling).
8. Climb in and out of and up and down into fire apparatus.
9. Cardio-vascular efficiency.
10. Respiratory compliance.
