# Summary of Results Spring 2023 - Admissions and Records Digital Form Survey

For Spring 2023, we received a total of 955 valid responses. It's important to highlight that the survey was voluntary, both in terms of participation and responses to individual questions.

- Provide clearer explanations on where to find necessary information, like using Starfish for form completion.
- Suggestions for making the major selection an open-ended question.
- Addition of detailed explanations or examples for questions, possibly through a mouse-over feature for clarification.
- Clarification on whether CHC and SBVC academic renewal requests are independent.
- Explanation of specific terms used in the form, such as what a 'catalog year' refers to.

I think it would be helpful to include guidance/brief instruction on next steps for student. For example, " if student does not see ap credit posted on transcript in 6-8 weeks, follow up with A&R", or provide the expected processing time since students will always ask this.

I was hesitant to start it and almost procrastinated because I was somehow under the impression that I \*needed\* to meet with someone to do it. I don't think there is anything to really be improved - it was easy to fill out - just maybe provide better explanations on where the correct information can be found.

## Disaggregated Data: (Hispanic)

The survey data shows that of 955 respondents, 378 (39.6%) identified as Hispanic. Based on student feedback, we've identified key areas for improvement to enhance usability and inclusivity, thereby enhancing the student experience and addressing any potential disproportionate impacts.

- Students found information on the form unclear such as the relationship between CHC and SBVC academic renewal requests.
  - Suggestion: Simplify language and provide clear, step-by-step instructions on forms. Include FAQs addressing common concerns like the distinction between CHC and SBVC academic renewal requests. Consider adding explanatory videos or graphics.
- While a majority prefer digital forms, there is a notable preference for paper or PDF forms.
  - Suggestion: Continue offering both digital and paper/PDF options to accommodate different preferences.
- Comments indicate confusion over certain parts of the form, such as the credit by examination section.
  - Suggestion: Highlight important sections and provide tooltips or pop-up explanations for complex terms or sections.

#### Disaggregated Data: (Caucasian)

The disaggregated survey data shows that out of 955 respondents, 224, approximately 23.5%, identified as Caucasian. Based on student feedback, we've identified key areas for improvement to enhance usability and inclusivity, thereby enhancing the student experience and addressing any potential disproportionate impacts.

- Students expressed a need for the inclusion of all majors, specifically mentioning "Human Services, Social Work," which was not listed.
  - > Suggestion: If possible, update the form to ensure every major is represented.
- Students showed a preference for paper or PDF forms due to issues with digital signatures.
  - Suggestion: Continue offering both digital and paper/PDF options to accommodate different preferences. Also consider implementing a more intuitive digital signature feature and/or instructions on how to use.
- Clearer definition of credit for prior learning, especially how dual enrollment listed on transcripts counts towards it.
  - Suggestion: Enhance the form's instructions by clarifying credit for prior learning with examples, such as dual enrollment.
- Students expressed confusion about what "catalog year" means on the form.
  - Suggestion: Provide a brief explanation or a tooltip next to the "catalog year" field on the form to clarify its meaning and significance.
