$\stackrel{\wedge}{\Longrightarrow}$	You must complete all application forms thoroughly and accurately and comply with all deadline dates. Misrepresenting information of financial aid applications is a violation of the law and is considered a criminal offense.
$\stackrel{\wedge}{\Longrightarrow}$	You must maintain satisfactory academic progress (at least 2.0 grade point average and you must successfully complete 67% or more of units attempted). You have the right to a copy of Crafton Hills College's Satisfactory Academic Policy (SAP). A copy of the policy is available upon request in the Financial Aid Office or at the CHC Financial Aid website.
\Rightarrow	Students who do not meet the percentage of units completed standard or the GPA standard will be placed on Financial Aid Warning automatically for the next subsequent semester providing it is determined that it is possible to reach the standard by the end of the subsequent semester.
$\stackrel{\wedge}{\Longrightarrow}$	Students who fail to satisfactorily complete a period of warning will be placed on <i>Unsatisfactory Progress Dismissal</i> . Students are not eligible to receive financial aid while on <i>Unsatisfactory Progress Dismissal</i> . In order to be considered for reinstatement, students are required to bring their cumulative GPA and percentage of units completed up to meet the standards without the receipt of federal financial aid.
\Rightarrow	You must return all additional documentation, verification form, and new information requested by the Financial Aid Office in a timely manner and in compliance with all deadlines. Our priority deadline is noon; June 2, 2016 to be considered for campus-based aid. Completion by the deadline will ensure your Federal Pell Grant is distributed in the first disbursement.
