Charge: The Educational Master Planning Committee relies on evidence (e.g. quantitative and qualitative research, learning assessment results, etc.) to facilitate and lead the effort to develop, review, and revise the Educational Master Plan (EMP) with input from appropriate constituencies. The Crafton EMP is a comprehensive document that establishes a clear direction for the College by envisioning the future of academics and student support under changing internal and external conditions. The EMPC regularly reviews the Educational Master Plan.

Membership: Two Vice Presidents (VPAS, VPSS, or VPI); President, Academic Senate or designee; President, Classified Senate or designee; one CSEA representative; President, Student Senate or designee; a faculty member, Planning and Program Review Committee; Director, Institutional Advancement; three additional faculty; one Instructional Dean; Dean, Institutional Effectiveness, Research & Planning.
