
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Goal: Student Success

 - ▶ Integrate student services so students can get help during any step in their college journey

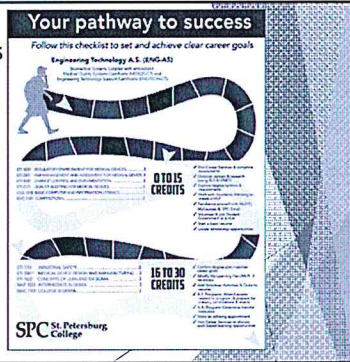
Four Pillars of an Effective Student Success Initiative

Clear Curriculum Maps

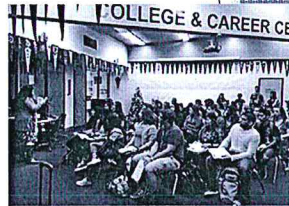
- ▶ Programs that are fully mapped out and aligned with further education and career advancement while also providing structured or guided exploration for undecided students.
