They would have to accept.- Develop cohort model- Honors-only classes to channel enrollment. Perhaps start with English 101 or 102- Continue with stacked classes- Concerns:<ul style="list-style-type: none">How would this affect H faculty contracts?Assumes students in cohort can take H-only class when we offer it- Could offer as asynchronous online course, but that is not the best introduction to the Honors model of engagement and connection.- Judy will reach out to community colleges that are our size and have Honors-only classes
