- 3. Operational Issues
 - CurricUNET update:
 - Kim and Gwen are currently cleaning up the non-credit content field and cross-listing field in CurricUNET and the information noted in the degrees field.
 - Most of the smaller CurricUNET issues are fixed.
 - Troy Dial provided an update on AB 1111 Common Course Numbering Project. By July 01, 2024, the California Community College will adopt a common course numbering system for all required general education courses and transfer pathway courses. There was mention of a clean-up legislation, California Community Colleges will have to meet certain requirements which will come after the 2024 deadline.
 - Joshua Robles informed the group that the Guided Pathways Committee has a sub-committee that will keep the MAPS updated. This may require both the Curriculum Committee and the Guided Pathways Sub Committee to meet to create a formal process, timeline, and frequency of updates.
