



This issue's topic: CHC is one of the Fastest Growing Colleges in the United States.

In the December 8, 2014 issue of Community College Weekly, Crafton Hills College was identified as one of the fastest growing colleges in the nation. When compared to colleges with enrollments from 5,000 to 9,999, Crafton was the ninth fastest growing college in the Nation from Fall 2012 to Fall 2013. Overall, community college enrollment in the United States declined 2.2%. Figure 1 illustrates the top ten fastest growing community colleges in the United States; 4 of the 10 community colleges are from California. Figure 2 shows the top ten fastest growing community colleges with 10,000 or more students; 7 of the 10 community colleges are from California. In addition, the top 5 were all from California.
