



Student Services Example: Extended Opportunities Programs & Services (EOP&S), Fall 2009:



1. SAO – Students understand that they are responsible for their own success in college, and take ownership through decision-making and positive action.




5. Possible Use of Results (Implications for Program Improvement & Planning) –

EXAMPLE – Greater emphasis on early identification of/intervention for high-risk students. Develop means of planning workshops that target student needs. Develop strategies to increase attendance at workshops and use of tutoring services. Implement these strategies and reassess their effectiveness.

2. Means of Assessment (Measurement Method) –

Recognition/tracking of positive student participation in program activities for FA 09 semester.



4. Summary of Data Collected (Results)

– Over 55% of students rated as adequate or excellent, these students are twice as likely to use tutoring and attend workshops than those rated below adequate (45%).
