16 of 16 (100%) personnel rated physician input 3 or higher.

32 of 32 (100%) students rated physician interaction 3 or higher.

Analysis: Year in, year out, this is one of the strongest areas surveyed. Students appreciate opportunities to meet area physicians and begin developing working relationships.
