1. Learning Outcomes Statement

Faculty who write honors course outlines will know all of the additional components required for inclusion in honors course outlines.

2. Means of Assessment (Measurement Method)

Course curriculum will be pulled from CurricuNet to assess inclusion of three out of the four components required for the outlines of honors courses. The four components are:

1. The student must show development of advanced writing skills through synthesis and original thought in expanded writing projects, research papers and critical essays. These should entail a minimum of ten pages of writing.
2. The honors experience should include substantially more reading and utilization of primary resources.
3. The student must show enhancement and enrichment through an outside-of-class activity or project.
4. The student must show development of oral communication skills requiring a 15 minute minimum presentation to the class.

Faculty will need to include in their outlines the appropriate components from the list above that are relevant to their specific honors courses.

3. Criteria for Success (Benchmark)

Of the faculty who write course outlines for honors courses, 100% will have the components necessary for inclusion in honors course outlines.
