Research Briefs from the Office of Institutional Research Number of Times Students Earn a GOR by PE Course

Purpose: The purpose of this brief is to illustrate the number of times students have earned a grade on record (GOR) in courses offered in PE/I and PE/T.

Methodology: Students were counted as earning a grade on record (GOR) if they earned one of the following grades from 2005 – 2006 to 2009 – 2010: A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I, or W. Table 1 illustrates the number of unduplicated GOR earned from 2005 – 2006 to 2009 – 2010 by PE course and the number and percent of students who earned only one GOR in the course, two GOR, three GOR, four GOR, and five GOR. The percent (“%”) of GOR earned was calculated by dividing the number (“#”) of GOR by the total number of “GOR” earned in each course.
