

Curriculum Report: December 1, 2010

The committee members continue to work on reviewing the course outlines which have been submitted.

We have approved a large number of course modifications, course deletions, and a few new courses.

The committee agreed upon the wording of Departmental recommendations on course outlines. Departmental recommendations will indicate “successful completion of a course, concurrent enrollment in a course, eligibility for a course, or ability to read at” The impact here is we wish to make them worded differently than prerequisites and will remove “eligibility for xx as determined through the Crafton Hills College assessment process” and leave it as “eligibility for”.

The committee is preparing to review any program changes that are coming through once the Transfer Model Curriculum (TMC) is developed and distributed by the Academic Senate for California Community Colleges and the C-ID System.

Anyone who has submitted courses, be sure to keep up with any approvals or changes that you need to make in order to keep the course moving along in the approval process.

Just a reminder: Any member of the campus can log on to CurricUNET and see what courses have been submitted; in addition, the curriculum agenda is always distributed to the entire campus and all are welcome to attend meetings. If you have a concern regarding a particular course, but cannot attend the meeting you can email your concern to the chair and it will be presented to the committee members. If you have a question about what was approved in the meetings you request to have monthly minutes sent to you or you can email the committee chair and just ask.
