

Curriculum Report: April 20, 2015

- Starting with May 2015 board meeting, the Board of Trustees will no longer have curriculum items on the consent agenda. They will now be placed on the action agenda. We have been told that courses that do not equate between the two campuses (Valley and Crafton) must have a justification as to why they do not equate. It was implied that the only reason that the Board could see for courses not equating was that they were not offered at both campuses. Therefore, if a course is offered at Valley College and Crafton Hills College and also has C-ID approval, it will need to equate at both campuses in order to be Board Approved.
