

1 **Resolution F14.01 - CHC Middle College High School**

2 **Whereas**, Board Policy stipulates that the College is to rely primarily upon the CHC Academic
3 Senate for “educational program development” and “the development of policies related to
4 institutional planning and budget development” and, as such, supports the growth of FTES as
5 follows:

- 6 1. By increasing courses and programs that focus on advancing the educational, career, and
7 personal success of our current students.
- 8 2. Through the implementation of athletics, which will attract new full-time student athletes
9 from our service area.
- 10 3. Through the development and implementation of a non-credit program, as identified by
11 AB86.

13 **Whereas**, A Middle College High School (MCHS) has not been identified as an area for growth,
14 and

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16 **Whereas**, The Academic Senate does not support the repurposing of Instructional Space without
17 a plan to replace that space, and

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19 **Whereas**, policies and procedures relating to both minors on campus and mandatory reporting
20 have not been adopted by the district, and

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22 **Whereas**, the Academic Senate has identified several areas of concern, such as impacts on
23 facilities, classes, traffic, parking, resources, and faculty workload related to hosting a MCHS
24 program at CHC.

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26 **Resolved**, that the CHC Academic Senate continue to fully support the prioritized areas of
27 growth as identified in the first Whereas, and

28 **Further resolved**, that the CHC Academic Senate explore the idea of and address the concerns
29 related to a MCHS to determine if such a program is a viable addition to the Academic programs
30 and services offered at CHC.
