## **Resolution FA15.03 ACCJC Follow-up Report Expectations**

Whereas, faculty roles and involvement in accreditation processes, including self-study and annual reports, is identified as an academic and professional matter as defined by Title 5 Section 53200;

Whereas, Board Policy 2510 states that "The Board embraces the concept of collegial consultation and to establish procedures to ensure faculty, management, classified staff, and students the right to participate effectively in collegial consultation in particular areas where they have their responsibility and expertise as specified in Title 5 regulations";

Whereas, the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC) found the San Bernardino Community College District (SBCCD) needing to resolve several deficiencies and has required San Bernardino Valley College (SBVC) to address these issues and demonstrate actions to resolve the noted deficiencies in their March 2016 Follow-up Report; and

Whereas, it is expected that the ACCJC Follow-up Report contains how these deficiencies have been resolved and the narrative analysis of how effective those resolutions were, including feedback from all campus constituencies and providing all accompanying evidence;

Therefore, should these expectations of the ACCJC Follow-up Report not be met, the SBVC Academic Senate reserves the right to not sign off on the report and to submit its own third party complaint to the ACCJC.
