- 1. Explanation of data:
  - A. Retention=earned grade @ end of semester divided by the number of students @ census
  - B. Success=earned passing grade @ end of semester divided by the number of students @ census

# 2. What is our job?

A. Ask questions about data: late start, short term, scheduling, length of class, different modes of delivery and 100% online vs. hybrid

- 3. What is our goal? To serve our students with supplemental courses, or to reach out of area students?
- 4. Should there be a First day orientation? Do students need this?
- 5. What is our line of communication when we see problems or patterns? Do we report to department chairs, meet with faculty, what is our role?
- 6. Who are our students? Which students take online classes, what about late start online classes?
- 7. Is there a difference between Fall and Spring students online, what is the "feel" of the students compared to f2f, are there the same differences?
- 8. Observations: five week classes do better,
- 9. Discussion: Online instructors reported they were more confident by third semester, being more realistic with assignments and more flexible with due dates for tests and papers.
