### Minutes

#### **Accrediting Commission Letter**

• Gloria Harrison reported that the Accrediting Commission sent a Revised Letter noting that the original letter had two errors: (1) CHC will have a visit by Commission representatives in the fall; (2) the college must have complete resolution with the exception of the SLO portion of Recommendation 3.

## Dr. Matthew Lee

Gloria introduced Dr. Matthew Lee, Special Projects Consultant for California Community Colleges. Dr. Lee will be with the District on a consulting basis for the next couple of years to assist with the accrediting process. He will be at CHC a couple days a week and his office will be located in LADM 300E. Dr. Lee has reviewed CHC's Self Study Report, Accreditation Report, and what we have been working on. He has submitted a report to the District which was distributed to the committee and will be distributed campus-wide. Dr. Lee will serve as a resource person to CHC.

Discussion took place regarding the work that needs to be completed. Dr. Lee made the following observations/recommendations:

- Recommendation #1 is the single most important item
- The Commission is interested in integration of planning. The Educational Master Plan must be integrated, overarching, well documented, and accurate
- CHC must have complete resolution by January 2011 or lose accreditation
- CHC has done a lot of brainstorming, has good ideas, but has not moved forward
- We need to come up with a Plan and put order to it that makes sense for the institution
- We need to revisit CHC's Goals to see if they are still applicable
- We must have a draft ready for Crafton Council by 9/3/07
- The Educational Master Plan needs to drive everything
- The Strategic Plan should include those things that don't fall into the Educational Master Plan; i.e., marketing issues

- The Strategic Plan articulates things we have to do in support of the Educational Master Plan
- Planning assumptions need to be spelled out
- Goals should be "what" not "how"
- Planning should take place from the bottom up and the top down
- Plans should not be redundant but should echo one another
- Campus participation is crucial
