Baltimore reporting format, followup and implementation	<p>Keith and Gary shared with the group their progress on the Baltimore reporting format. Departments and units have been added to the site. Their SLO information will be reported on a five-step template and placed on the website. Many courses have collected data but have not completed a cycle. The website should include all progress on SLOs. The quality of SLO's varies widely. Subsequent discussions must center on effective outcome design and assessment. The group also discussed whether the site should be transparent only to the campus community or if the public should have access.</p> <p>The group recommended that the site is shared with Senate.
