- Persistence- No discussion
- Retention- Not addressed (3)
- Pass Rate- Not addressed (3)
- Enrollment- increase is mentioned although not supported by data
- Faculty Ratio- 70% part time instructors (1)
- Marketing/Outreach (1.5)- Unit should develop plan to market upper division courses
