

## **Sample SLOs for: Emergency Medical Services**

1. Function as a competent, entry level Nationally Registered Paramedic (COK).
2. Use critical thinking and decision making skills to perform a differential diagnosis, identify patient care priorities, develop a patient care plan, and then execute that plan (COK, CRT).
3. Demonstrate verbal and written communication skills consistent with the practice of pre-hospital medicine (COK, LWC).
4. Function efficiently and effectively as a member of a healthcare team, including treating all patients with dignity, respect and courtesy consistent with the standards of the profession (COK, COM, IIT).
5. Demonstrate professional and ethical behavior in all aspects of Paramedic care (COK, RES).
