Interdisciplinary Studies

Students who major in Interdisciplinary Studies will:

Write a mission statement that reflects personal, academic, career and life goals;

Develop a plan for attaining life objectives and take responsibility for monitoring, evaluating and updating that plan;

Articulate and apply theories, methods and critical perspectives from at least two academic disciplines;

Demonstrate the common thread connecting these disciplines;

Analyze the similarities and differences between the ways knowledge is constructed and used in the disciplines studied;

Acquire strong research and writing skills; and

Examine and discuss values gained through education and how such values can impact community through personal, civic, professional or scholarly life.
