1. Student Learning Outcomes Statement

Students will have knowledge of and know how to apply the six CAS standards when scheduling events sponsored by Student Life.

2. Means of Assessment (Measurement Method)

Classify each event for the 2011 – 2012 year under one of the six CAS categories.

3. Criteria for Success (Benchmark)

All events will be classified into one of the six CAS categories.

4. Summary of Evidence

Student Senate and department staff have received a brief training on the CAS Standards for Student Life during the Spring 2012 Winter Retreat and have a reference poster listing the 6 categories posted in the office. They discussed all events for Spring 2012 and classified each event into one of the six categories.

5. Use of Results (Implications for Program Improvement & Planning)

Continuously teach staff and students the six standards identified for Student Life programs and help the group tailor CHC's Student Activities Program to meet those needs. Work with the ORP to develop a survey to assess student and staff knowledge of the CAS standards and their impact on institutional effectiveness. Administer in the 2012 – 2013 academic year and use to inform development of future trainings.
