Notes: 1) Chemistry, Foreign Language, Speech, and Art were originally set to complete a three-year plan in 12-13 and this was moved to 13-14. Three of these programs were left in 13-14. 2) The Transfer Center has not yet completed a three-year plan because it is a new program, which was also kept in 13-14. 3) Marketing was planned to do their first three-year plan in 13-14 but there is currently no director, and was moved to 15-16 to give the new Director two years to become familiar with the program at Crafton. 4) Exemplarily programs were scheduled to conduct a three-year plan in 13-14 were moved to 14-15: OIERP, CDE, Child Development Center, and CIS. 5) Next, the two programs that were identified as Strong Programs were moved to 14-15: Fire Academy and Paramedics. The programs were then scheduled based on their past performance on the rubric and document quality scores. In addition, an attempt was made to balance the number of four-year plans without having too many programs doing a program review in the same division: RADTECH was moved from 14-15 to 13-14, Child Care Center was moved from 14-15 to 15-16, and CDE was moved from 14-15 to 16-17, CHC College Life was moved from 16-17 to 14-15, A&R was moved from 15-16 to 16-17, moved Art from 13-14 to 14-15, moved the Honors Program from 15-16 to 14-15, moved Technology Services from 14-15 to 13-14, and moved Maintenance and Grounds from 15-16 to 16-17.
