





Crafton Hills College Cities with the Highest Increase of Hispanic Students from Fall 2005 to Fall 2009






Beaumont increased from 58 students in Fall 2005 to 160 in Fall 2009, an increase of 102 students or 176%.









Crafton Hills College Cities with the Highest Increase of Hispanic Students from Fall 2005 to Fall 2009











Rancho Cucamonga increased from 9 students in Fall 2005 to 20 in Fall 2009, an increase of 11 students or 122%.



Most of the growth that occurs in the Inland Empire will occur in the San Jacinto Valley.


