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Research Briefs from the Office of Institutional Research Crafton Hills College (CHC) Student Developmental Course Success Rates

Purpose: This brief illustrates the success rates in developmental English, reading, and math courses from 2007 – 2008 to 2009 – 2010.

Methodology: Developmental courses include basic skills and college level courses that are not transferable. Success rate (SR) is defined as earning a grade on record (GOR, i.e. A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I, or W) divided by the number of A, B, C, or P grades.
