3. MATH 108/PSYCH 108 Discussion

The curriculum committee and the MATH department and PSYCH department agreed to approve deleting the existing MATH 108 and PSYCH 108 courses and the departments develop two new courses that will not be cross-listed as STATS classes. Once new courses are approved by articulation then the existing courses will be deleted, this process should take approximately two years at the most. Both courses will remain in existence until the process has been completed.
