6.1, 6.2	A1	Budgeting processes should be posted and available to all publicly (perhaps budget steering committee). Processes and protocol should be documented and published. Decisions should be well explained with reasons why/why not.

6.1	C2	Streamline information — Can we find a Clif's Notes version of committees information?
6.2	C2	Solicit managers to gather input from their employees to increase participation.
