\*Students who participate who are interested in attending SBVC will not receive priority registration and the orientation class is not recommended.

\*\*This means you will have a better chance to get the classes you want at the times you want them.

All students who complete the following steps will be guaranteed a "Priority F" status (one step higher than new students who come to the Crafton Hills College campus to apply for admission) for registration. This means you will have a better chance to get the classes you want at the times you want them.

Follow these steps and be ready to sign up for summer and fall classes without a visit to Crafton Hills College:

- 1. **Apply for Admission April 14, 2:50 4:30 Library** A representative of Crafton Hills College will give a brief orientation and assist you with your online application.
- 2. Complete the Assessment process April 21, 2:50 5:30 Library All incoming students to Crafton Hills College, (and SBVC) are required to complete an assessment to determine appropriate placement in English and mathematics and reading.
- 3. See a Counselor April 25 or April 26, 2:50 to 4:30 College/Career Development B44 See a CHC (or SBVC) counselor to review your assessment, to develop a first semester educational plan (SEP) and to discuss your educational goals. Sign up on April 21 for a 1.5 hour counseling session scheduled for April 25 or April 26

Sign up with Mrs. Colvey in the College/Career Development – B44 <u>through April 15</u> to guarantee your spot.

START COLLEGE BEFORE YOU GRADUATE!

Move up to "Priority E" registration status and complete the CHC Freshman Orientation Requirement before you graduate from high school!

This is only for students who plan to attend Crafton Hills College next year. Once you have completed all the steps above you may enroll <u>in PCD 050 College Orientation</u> course, which will be offered here at SGHS after school on May 3 and 4 This will guarantee you <u>"Priority E"</u> status (the same as all students who have <u>already</u> completed one semester at CHC does not apply for SBVC students) for enrollment in summer and fall.

## START COLLEGE BEFORE YOU GRADUATE AND BEGIN AT CHC ONE STEP AHEAD OF OTHER ENTERING FRESHMAN

## Procedure for enrollment:

- Pick up an enrollment packet from Ms. Colvey the College/Career Development - B44
- 2. Complete the Application, Assessment and Counseling Process (sign up for the "SOA<sup>3</sup>R" offered at SGHS on April 14 through April 26

All students who enroll in the course will be guaranteed "Priority E" status (the same as CHC students who have completed their first semester) for enrollment in summer and fall courses.

## Instructions for completing attached packet:

- Complete a CHC Application for Admission for enrollment in SPRING 2011 (See attached directions)
- 2. Complete attached HIGH SCHOOL CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT REQUEST. Have a parent or legal guardian complete and sign the Parent/Guardian Consent form (unless you are 18 on or before DATE OF CLASS)
- Bring the <u>completed</u> packet with \$1.25 cash or check made out to *Crafton Hills College* to Ms Colvey in the College/Career Development –B44 on or before May 3
- 4. Attend class on May 3 and 4 2:50 to 5:00.
