Discuss the Objective Prioritization Process and agree on PPRC approach (30 minutes)	<p>Suggestions include only prioritizing the objectives with resources attached to them, and doing the ones near the top (perhaps the top 50).</p> <p>One suggestion was to separate objectives with and without resources. Prioritize the objectives without resources attached to them separately because the objectives with and without resources do not need to compete with each other. If an objective doesn't have a resource it exists at the unit level and they can implement on their own with no need for resources.</p> <p>The PPRC also discussed how if we only prioritized objectives with resources we could be missing important college directions. Only prioritizing objectives with resources would also communicate that non-funded objectives are not important.</p> <p>A committee member also made the point that objectives without resources should not need to compete with objectives for resources.
