## **Student Success Project**

Our proposal for Student Success was funded by the Board at the January meeting. We will receive \$148,000 for the 2013-2014 AY to supplement State and grant funds. I emailed the full proposal to the campus in December, but let me know if you want another copy. The project includes:

- Expansion of the Left Lane Project
- Increased Tutoring and Counseling hours
- Piloting the use of tablets and other technical support in the classroom
- The development of Directed Learning Activities (DLAs)
- Enhancing the website to clarify educational pathways (e.g., certificates, degrees, and transfer)
- Instituting Educational Plans for every student
- Enhancing Professional Development related to the Student Success Initiative

### **Budget Study**

The Budget Study conducted by The College Brain Trust is complete. The VPs and I are reviewing it in preparation for a special Chancellor's Cabinet meeting on January 30. After our initial discussion, the study will be broadly distributed and it will be on the February 13 meeting agenda of the District Budget Committee. Dialogue will continue throughout the Spring semester regarding the recommendations. There is not yet a timeline for decisions about Crafton's budget.

#### **Title V Grant**

The opportunity to apply for a Title V Coop Grant is expected this year and would be due in March. Several ideas have come forward and these will be discussed at an Open Forum on Wednesday, January 29 at noon in LRC 226. You are welcome to come hear about the ideas and share your input. ### **New Faculty**

I am thrilled to have two new faculty this Spring. Jeff Cervantez has joined us to lead the Philosophy and Religious Studies discipline. We will also have a Career Counselor join us after the February Board Meeting.

- Bachelor of Arts, Early Childhood Education
- Bachelor of Arts, Liberal Studies

More information will be forthcoming, but these classes will be available to both students and employees. They will also be interested in talking to CHC employees who are qualified to teach in these programs.
