# **Budget**

After much dialogue in the District Budget Committee, the allocation for Crafton was increased to 31.38%. This percentage is based on the actual production of FTEs during what's called P2 (the second report to the State). This was a large team effort and I appreciate <u>everyone's</u> contribution, including serving more students, advocating for growth, and managing enrollment – just to name a few of the ways you all helped. The 14-15 budget is still in development; a tentative budget is scheduled to be presented to the Board at a Study Session on May 29, so we will know more after that.

# **Change in Opening Day**

When we begin in the Fall, our <u>In Service Day will be held on Monday</u>, <u>August 18</u>, and classes will begin on Tuesday, August 19. A Flex Day is scheduled for Friday, August 15.

#### Hiring

We have a large number of vacancies due to retirements and resignations. Our immediate plans are:

- Recruit for 1 Year Temporary Faculty in Chemistry, Business (Accounting) and Fire Full searches will be conducted next year for permanent positions.
- Adjuncts will be used in Respiratory due to the difficulty in finding a full time temporary instructor.

- Counselor An offer is being extended with hopes of the name going to June Board

- Division Administrative Secretary Closed in mid-April
- Senior Student Services Tech Internal announcement to CSEA
- Physics Lab Tech Interviews on June 3

Future positions will be filled if the budget allows for it.
