The findings in this report stem from the 2022-2023 Athletics Satisfaction Student Survey, with a total of 17 valid responses collected. The survey asked student-athletes to provide feedback on various aspects of their experience in the athletics program, including the accessibility of facilities, the inclusiveness of their teams, and the quality of coaching received. It is important to note that participation in the survey, as well as responses to individual questions, was voluntary.

Summary of Key Findings

- 94.1% of student-athletes found the process of becoming a student-athlete easy to understand.
- 94% agreed that equipment and facilities were accessible, and 94% were satisfied with the locker room facilities.
- 94% knew where to access on-campus support, and 88% felt they could balance academics and athletics.
- 87% felt their teammates created an inclusive environment, and 100% agreed that coaches treated them with respect.
- 94% were satisfied with the overall athletics program at CHC.
- Only a small percentage expressed dissatisfaction with aspects such as inclusivity among teammates, facility access, and communication. No explanation was given.

Note: These findings are based on a small sample size, so interpretations should take into account the limited data available.
