# **Key Findings and Recommendations**

### **Teaching Effectiveness**

- **58% agreed** (Strongly Agree/Agree) concepts were explained clearly, while **25% disagreed**, and **17% were neutral**. Feedback noted overly complicated explanations and insufficient alignment with assessments. Simplifying content and ensuring stronger connections between instruction and exams would address these concerns.
- **92% agreed** participation was encouraged, with **8% neutral**, reflecting a strong area of the course. Creating a more welcoming environment could further support student engagement.
- **92% agreed** interactions were respectful and professional, with **8% neutral**, showing this as a strength to maintain.
- **64% agreed** there was clear support for student success, while **9% disagreed**, and **27% were neutral**, suggesting a need for consistent office hours and more proactive student support.

#### **Course Content and Structure**

- 83% agreed (Strongly Agree/Agree) that the course materials were relevant and helpful, while 8% disagreed, and 8% were neutral. Feedback indicated that unfamiliar systems used for convenience caused confusion. Streamlining tools and platforms could address this.
- **83% agreed** the grading criteria were fair and transparent, with **17% neutral**, reflecting a strong area of the course.
- 83% agreed assignments and exams reflected course content, while 8% disagreed, and 8% were neutral. Students noted that some exam material was not adequately covered in class, suggesting a need for better alignment between teaching and assessments.
- 83% agreed the course improved their knowledge, while 8% disagreed, and 8% were neutral. Feedback suggests ensuring that all course content aligns with learning objectives to address isolated dissatisfaction.

#### **Communication and Accessibility**

- 92% agreed (Strongly Agree/Agree) that questions were responded to in a timely manner, while 8% disagreed, reflecting a strong area of the course. Maintaining prompt responses will support student satisfaction.
- 83% agreed course updates and materials were communicated clearly, while 17% were neutral, with no direct disagreement. Feedback indicated potential confusion around updates, suggesting a need for clearer organization and delivery of materials.

#### **Flexibility and Accommodation**

- 75% agreed (Strongly Agree/Agree) that reasonable accommodation was provided, while 8% disagreed, and 17% were neutral. Feedback highlighted instances of inflexibility during emergencies, suggesting the need for clearer and more empathetic policies for accommodation.
- 58% agreed support for student well-being was available, while 8% disagreed, and 33% were
  neutral. This indicates room for improvement in addressing personal challenges, particularly in
  crisis situations

# Student Engagement and Participation

- 73% agreed (Strongly Agree/Agree) the course fostered engagement and inclusivity, while 18% disagreed, and 9% were neutral. Feedback noted challenges in fostering a supportive environment, with some students describing it as "toxic." Creating a more inclusive and welcoming atmosphere could address this issue.
- **73% agreed** the course encouraged critical thinking, while **9% disagreed**, and **18% were neutral**, indicating room to further promote deeper engagement and encourage active participation.

## **Embedded Tutor Support**

- 73% agreed (Strongly Agree/Agree) that the embedded tutor supported their learning, while 0% disagreed, and 27% selected N/A, indicating some students did not have access to or interaction with an embedded tutor. Strengthening tutor integration and visibility could enhance their impact.
- 55% agreed the tutor provided helpful feedback during class activities, while 18% disagreed, and 27% selected N/A. Feedback highlighted occasional corrections by the instructor.

## **Overall Experience**

- **67% agreed** (Strongly Agree/Agree) that the course met their expectations and supported their academic goals, while **11% disagreed**, and **22% were neutral**, suggesting some misalignment between course delivery and student goals. Clearer alignment of content and expectations could improve this area.
- 67% agreed they would recommend the course to other students, while 11% disagreed, and 22% were neutral, indicating that organizational and communication improvements could enhance overall satisfaction.
