# **Research Brief**

SOAR Survey Assessment Prepared by Jodi Buckley

#### **Purpose of Brief**

This brief describes the results of the SOAR Spring 2018 event.

#### Summary of Findings

- 98% of respondents either strongly agreed or agreed they would recommend to future seniors planning to attend Crafton Hills College to participate in the SOAR program.
- 99% of respondents either strongly agreed or agreed they felt the KICKOFF presenters were well prepared.
- 89% of respondents either strongly agreed or agreed they felt adequately prepared to take the assessment test.
- 96% of respondents either strongly agreed or agreed the presenters were easy to understand.
- 94% of respondents either strongly agreed or agreed they understood how to register for classes

#### **Overview**

SOAR contacted the Office of Institutional Effectiveness, Research & Planning (OIERP) to conduct a survey to gain the participant experience of the Spring SOAR event. The information provided in the report illustrates the student responses to the questions posed on the survey.

### **Methodology**

An online survey instrument was developed by the Office on Institutional Effectiveness, Research and Planning in conjunction with the Counseling Department. The survey was administered to high school students immediately after participating in a SOAR activity at their school site. The survey contained Likert scaled questions which measured respondent subject comprehension and satisfaction. Lastly, 4 open-ended questions elicited comments regarding suggestions for improvement of each section of the program. A total of 261 responses were received.

## **Findings**

The participants of the SOAR event were asked to provide their feedback regarding their overall experience of the SOAR event. The participants were asked to rate their experience as either strongly agreed, agreed, disagree, or strongly disagree. The questions and results to the respondents' overall experience with the SOAR event are presented in Table 1.

The participants were asked to provide their feedback regarding the "KICKOFF" portion of the SOAR event. Table 2 identifies the questions the participants were asked in reference to the, "KICKOFF- Day I" segment. The respondents' rated their level of agreement with the following statements that ranged from strongly agree, agree, disagree, and strongly disagreed. The questions and results are presented in Table 2.

The participants were asked to provide their feedback regarding the Assessment portion of the SOAR event. The participants were asked to provide feedback regarding their experience during the "ASSESSMENT- Day 2" portion of the SOAR event. The respondents rated their level of agreement to the question, "I felt adequately prepared to take the assessment," by indicating if they strongly agreed, agreed, disagreed, or strongly disagreed. Eighty-nine percent of the students either strongly agreed or agreed they felt adequately prepared to take the assessment test. The question and results are presented in Table 3.

Table 4 illustrates the responses to the dichotomous questions regarding the Advising portion of the SOAR event. Ninety-nine percent of the respondents either strongly agreed or agreed the advising presentations were valuable and they felt well prepared. Ninety-four percent of the respondents either strongly agreed or agreed they understood how to register for classes.
