Membership

Qualifications

- **New students:** 3.25 high school GPA
- **Crafton students:** 3.25 GPA with 12 transferable units (100 level and above)
- **All students:** Eligible for college-level English (English 101 or higher)

Participation

- Complete at least one Honors course and meet with Honors counselor each year
- Maintain a 3.25 minimum cumulative GPA

Completion

- Complete 15 semester units of Honors courses with a grade of A or B
- Achieve a cumulative college GPA of 3.25 or higher in transferable courses
- Complete 15 community service hours
