- Students may apply with prerequisite coursework in progress; however, all prerequisite requirements must be completed before MBKU's fall term begins (mid-August)
- The courses below must be completed with a grade of "C-" or better

General Microbiology/Bacteriology w/lab	MICRO 102 or 150	3 semester units or 4 quarter units
General Physics w/lab	PHYSIC 110, 111	2 semesters (minimum of 8 semester units) or 3 quarters (minimum of 12 quarter units)
General Chemistry w/lab	CHEM 150, 151	2 semesters (minimum of 8 semester units) or 3 quarters (minimum of 12 quarter units)
Organic Chemistry (no lab required)	CHEM 102	3 semester units or 4 quarter units
Psychology	PSYCH 100	3 semester units or 4 quarter units
English Composition or Literature (AP credit accepted for 1 of the 2 required courses)	ENG 101 & one additional course offered by ENG Dept.	6 semester units or 8 quarter units
Statistics	MATH 110	3 semester units or 4 quarter units
Human Anatomy w/lab *	ANAT 150 and 151 Must complete series	3 semester units or 4 quarter units
Human Physiology w/lab *	ANAT 150 and 151 Must complete series	3 semester units or 4 quarter units
Bio Chemistry (no lab required)	Not Offered	3 semester units or 4 quarter units

- \* Human Anatomy and Physiology (Human A&P) may be completed one of two ways:
  - Combined Human A&P (6 semester units or 8 quarter units with 2 labs)
  - Separate Human Anatomy and Human Physiology (3 semester units or 4 quarter units EACH with 2 labs)
