ADT Transfer Scholarship

This NU scholarship is intended for California Community College(CCC) students that participate in a CCC-Associate Degree for Transfer(ADT) and meet the minimum eligibility requirements that are fully transferable and guarantee admission into National University. Students will eventually hold an associate's degree and a bachelor's degree upon completion of their program at NU.

To be eligible for this award, students must meet the following qualifications:

- Have participated in a CCC-ADT program, that guarantees an Associate of Arts in Transfer and/or Associate of Science for transfer and have meet the transfer requirements
- Be enrolled into a program that is part of the Associate Degree for Transfer Pathway

Verification Procedure:

- Admissions Advisor
 - At the time of enrollment determine if student completed a CCC-ADT program or a transferable Associate Degree, within the last 12 months, and admit to the NU degree program that correlates to ADT. (See list below)
 - Once student is admitted add the Service Indicator
 - RDP- ADT Preliminary Eligible
- Office or the Registrar: Evaluations
 - Will determine eligibility during evaluation process
 - Service Indicator will be added
 - RDE – ADT Eligible
 - RDD – ADT Denied
 - If eligible, Financial Aid Processing will be notified, and scholarship will be added

Course and Scheduling Information:

- Students will receive 90 quarter units in transfer
- CCC-ADT will fulfill all General Education and lower division prep requirements
- Student must meet the following:
 - Upper Division GE
 - Diversity GE Verification
 - Core and Elective Courses
 - Potential of 3 Open Electives to meet 180 quarter unit degree requirement

Scholarship Details: ADT Transfer Scholarship is a limited-time, non-transferable offer for individuals who meet specific terms and conditions as outlined in the following. The scholarship is offered to students who are enrolled in a program directly associated to the CCC-ADT program that they were enrolled in at the community college. Some federal financial aid, cohort, military, or reimbursement programs may affect eligibility. This is an exclusive, non-transferable scholarship offer for students. Scholarship will be forfeited should student change from program that they were originally admitted into. Applicants must remain in active status and in good academic standing with the University. Scholarship funds will only be applied toward the tuition cost for academic coursework in increments of \$880 per course, assuming a 30-month completion plan consisting of a minimum of 17 and maximum of 20 courses. This will be paid in accordance with the Scholarship Department.
