Additionally, there's a proposal for a committee dedicated to showing gratitude to our firefighters and another committee for planning 'Jam Out'.

We also reviewed club charters for the Christianity Club, Mathematics Club, and DND Club, and discussed updates for the upcoming Club Rush event. Further, there was a proposal to allocate \$1,200 to support both the Christmas Club and a broader student event.

The Senate discussed and approved changes to our bylaws.

A noteworthy item on the agenda was a presentation by Larry Aycock on the Booksaver program. This presentation offered insights into the program's structure, anticipated benefits, and impact on student expenses. Senators had the opportunity to ask questions and provide feedback to shape how Booksaver can best serve our campus.

A financial report was given by director Van Stee. Finally, there was an opportunity to hear from Brandon Cooley of RIX LAD on enhancing student engagement.
