Granting The Title And Rank Of Professor Emeritus For Elizabeth "Liz" Langenfeld.

Whereas, Liz Langenfeld has dedicated 16 years of dynamic and heartfelt service to Crafton Hills College, going beyond meeting the needs of students by supplying varied modalities of instruction as an esteemed English instructor, ensuring that faculty and student voices were heard in the work of building learning communities, promoting student clubs and student centered events, supporting pathways and partnerships, and championing scholarship opportunities and the CHC Honors program.

Whereas, Liz always considered her students first and foremost, and fostered and nurtured their college experiences to help them achieve individual best success and capitalized on this in her work to help develop the Early Alert Program that led to our current Starfish, the development of the basic skills writing courses 976 Project where she worked as a liaison between part-time and full-time English and Reading faculty to help raise and maintain reading and writing standards, and participation in the EAP/Common Core Initiative to foster student college and career readiness.

Whereas, Liz has supported the growth of fellow faculty and our institution in vital and varied ways including serving as compassionate and steadfast English Department chair from 2010-2012, advocating for her peers and the voices of faculty in matriculation, curriculum, accreditation, educational policies, and dedicated service to Academic Senate.
