

WHEREAS, Kim H. McCormick was employed by the San Bernardino Community College District (SBCCD) for fifteen years; and

WHEREAS, she conducted outreach in the community and developed strong relationships with seven area Chambers of Commerce, fifteen non-profits and utility companies, ten transfer colleges, eleven high schools, eight government agencies and 1,500 private businesses; organized twelve major campus events and the *Exploration of Majors and Careers* series; focusing on one or more Crafton Hills and San Bernardino Valley majors, e.g., environmental careers, emergency services, library technology and including seasonal and summer job fairs each semester; and

WHEREAS, she was an outstanding faculty member and a tireless advocate for her students by assisting them in customizing their resumes and developing interviewing techniques; and arranging for eighty individual companies to come to the campuses to recruit and interview for jobs; and

WHEREAS, she was the Coordinator of, and a valued leader in the Cooperative Work Experience Program for nine years, where she developed an internship program in which 44% of the students were hired and twenty-five percent of her students (not in the internship program) received pay raises and/or promotions each semester;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Kim H. McCormick be granted the title and rank of Professor Emeritus and all the rights and privileges associated therein.
