 comprehensive courses and programs that require the use of a Gymnasium, and
- 9 Whereas, the Academic Senate supports the Health and Kinesiology Department's request to
- explore the feasibility of reusing or remodeling the current Gym or building a new Gym on the
- 11 current Gym site, and
- 12 Whereas, the Academic Senate believes that facility planning should not drive instructional
- decisions; rather, planning and program review processes should identify the best use of both
- 14 existing and future CHC facilities.
- 15 **Resolved,** that the CHC Academic Senate recommend the College perform an analysis of the
- 16 cost to upgrade the gymnasium building vs. tearing it down as recommended in objective ID #10
- of the 5/10/11 meeting notes on page 108 of the Master Plan Update document from August
- 18 2011.
- 19 Further Resolved, the CHC Academic Senate recommend the College reevaluate current and
- 20 future facilities plans to assure the plans align with program needs as articulated through
- 21 planning and program review.
