- Whereas, A Middle College High School (MCHS) has not been identified as an area for growth,
 and
- Whereas, The Academic Senate does not support the repurposing of Instructional Space without
 a plan to replace that space, and
- Whereas, policies and procedures relating to minors on campus have not been vetted or adopted
 by the district, and
- Whereas, the Academic Senate has identified several areas of concern, such as impacts on
 facilities, classes, traffic, parking, resources, and faculty workload related to hosting a MCHS
 program at CHC.
- Resolved, that the CHC Academic Senate continue to fully support the prioritized areas of
 growth as identified in the first Whereas, and
- Further resolved, that the CHC Academic Senate explore the idea of and address the concerns related to a MCHS to determine if such a program is a viable addition to the Academic programs and services offered at CHC.
