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WHEREAS, faculty chairs are also responsible for the recruitment of new part-time faculty and
staff and also serve as the peer evaluator or recommend an appropriate faculty designee for part time faculty evaluations, and

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WHEREAS, faculty chairs are also responsible for maintaining regular and effective modes of communication with administration, faculty, staff, students and community on areas of interest to the programs, and

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15 WHEREAS, 13% of CHC full-time faculty members currently do not belong to an established

16 department and therefore are not represented at the Chairs' council meetings and as such are not fully represented in compute planning deliberations including resource requests, and biring

17 fully represented in campus planning deliberations including resource requests, and hiring

18 prioritizations, and

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- 20 **RESOLVED**, CHC establish a new faculty chair position that will represent all non-instructional
- 21 faculty currently without faculty chair representation, and

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- 23 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the non-instructional faculty chair assume all applicable duties
- and responsibilities as defined in Appendix A-4b of the CTA contract.
