## International Program Researcher Job Description

The International Program Researcher, under the direction of the Vice President of Instruction, will research and develop a draft implementation plan for adding an International program at Crafton Hills College.

Research and planning (.5 release) Spring of 2016

- 1. Demonstrate the need for an international program. Need should be demonstrated through a cost benefit analysis and baseline data contextualized within the framework, goals and objectives of the CHC Educational Master Plan.
- 2. Research a sampling of California Community College based international programs and provide a summary of findings.
- 3. Research the policies, procedures, programs and support services that are required or need to be enhanced in order to provide a quality International Program at Crafton Hills College
- 4. Present the associated research for review and recommendation to the Academic Senate and to the Crafton Council.
- 5. Develop a plan, if deemed appropriate by the Academic Senate, that outlines the goals and objectives for an International program as well as a timeline, budget and resources for implementing the International policies, procedures, programs and support services that are required in order to provide a quality International Program at Crafton Hills College.
- 6. Develop a list of Duties and Responsibilities that would be required of a full-time International Program Coordinator at CHC.
