CANVAS FUNDAMENTAL SERIES

NAVIGATING THE USER INTERFACE

This Fundamentals Series training provides users with a hands-on tour of the Canvas User Interface. Participants will explore the dashboard and global navigation features including; personal settings, files, notifications, inbox, calendar, the help menu and more.

BUILDING COURSE CONTENT

This Fundamentals Series training provides users with a hands-on overview of course content creation tools including; pages, assignments, quizzes and discussions. Users will explore how to leverage course content, maximize student engagement and utilize progress monitoring capabilities found in Modules.

STRUCTURING YOUR CANVAS COURSE

This Fundamentals Series training encourages users to explore Canvas tools that can facilitate optimal learning experiences which engage and promote student success. Participants will explore the grading process, course design features and ways to communicate with students across multiple channels in Canvas.

CANVAS INSTRUCTOR SERIES

Audience: The Instructor Series has a variety of possible sessions geared towards assisting staff and faculty working in different roles.

CANVAS MOBILE APPS

This training is designed to help teachers better understand the many ways the Canvas mobile apps suite can improve the classroom experience for both students and teachers. During this webinar you will learn the features and functionality of the Canvas app, how to improve assessment workflow using the SpeedGrader and Magic Marker apps, how to increase engagement using Polls.

STRATEGIES FOR TRAIN THE TRAINER

This training introduces participants to effective practices and strategies for training others on using Canvas. Participants compare and discuss the needs of their institution, and explore which training initiatives might work best for them. They also learn about the training materials and opportunities provided by Instructure and the greater Canvas

CANVAS INSTRUCTOR SERIES, cntd.

CANVAS VISUAL INSTRUCTIONAL DESIGN

This session reviews techniques for branding and customization inside Canvas. It introduces participants to visual design ideas and tools. It discusses defining your audience for a Canvas course and designing with responsiveness, functionality, attractiveness, and ease of use in mind.

CANVAS ASSIGNMENTS AND GRADING

This training introduces features used by instructors to provide assessment, feedback, and grades to student submissions in Canvas. Participants will see how to employ Rubrics, the Gradebook, and SpeedGrader™ (including the Annotation tool) to assess student work. This session may include best practices for making the grading workflow as efficient as possible.

CANVAS OUTCOMES AND RUBRICS

This training reviews best practices of utilizing outcomes and rubrics in Canvas assignments, discussions and quizzes, along with specific applications of the Learning Mastery Gradebook and the Canvas Magic Marker app.

LEVERAGING THE CANVAS COMMONS

The Canvas Commons is a learning object repository that allows Canvas users to quickly and easily share courses, and course content with others. This training provides an overview of its many features along with strategies of how to best utilize this powerful tool.

CANVAS COLLABORATION AND GROUP WORK

This training introduces teachers to collaboration features in Canvas, including discussions, group assignments, the Collaborations tool, and web conferencing. Participants will discuss how these tools can be used to enhance their class activities.

CANVAS COURSE FACILITATOR TRAINING

This training prepares teachers who will facilitate pre-designed courses in Canvas. Participants will learn how to adjust account settings, navigate the Canvas interface, grade student work, manage the course roster, access Canvas support, and communicate with their students.



CANVAS ADMIN SERIES

STRUCTURING CANVAS

This training introduces Canvas Administrators to the underlying structure of the Learning Management System. Topics covered during this sessions include: Sub-Accounts, Courses, Sections, Terms, Users, Permissions, Authentication, and the Theme Editor.

CANVAS ACCOUNT SETTINGS

This training introduces Canvas Administration to the global settings in Canvas. Topics covered in this training include: Account Settings, Storage Quotas, Notifications, Announcements, LTI Apps and Feature Options.

BEING AN EVERYDAY ADMIN

This training covers topics helpful to new Canvas Admins in the everyday administration of Canvas. Topics covered include: managing users, managing shared resources, using the Canvas Community, Admin Tools, getting/interpreting data and Analytics from Canvas.

MANAGING ACCOUNT LEVEL CONTENT

This training will discuss the differences in creating and importing content within Canvas at the Admin level. The trainer will introduce participants to three possible avenues of account level content creation: manual, .csv file uploads, and SIS integration. This session will involve hands on practice doing bulk uploads of sub-accounts, courses, terms, sections, users and enrollments manually via a .csv file upload.
