7. Faculty roles and involvement in accreditation processes.
8. Policies for faculty professional development activities.
9. Processes for program review.
10. Processes for institutional planning and budget development.
11. Other academic and professional matters as mutually agreed upon.

Consult Collegially means that the district governing board shall develop policies on academic and professional matters through either or both of the following:

- Rely primarily upon the advice and judgment of the academic senate, OR

The governing board, or its designees, and the academic senate shall reach mutual agreement by written resolution, regulation, or policy of the governing board effectuating such recommendations.

May put some limits on the courses. Online classes are not identified on the transcripts.</p>	Motion: that DE addendums be allowed for Honors courses, as long as the regular course has a DE addendum (Brink, Hendrickson, MSC).
Curriculum Committee Recommendation	<p>Background: Title 5 was changed in July 2017 and now requires both in class and out of class hours on our course outlines of record. In addition, we must place both minimums and maximums and total both of them. To adhere to this change, the Curriculum Committee would like the Academic Senate to approve the newly proposed structure for the Course outlines of Record. (See sample docs as posted):</p> <p>State has decided we need to change how the course outlines are written. Now have to have lecture time as well as outside time noted in course outline. Curriculum needs direction from senate about how these need to look. Will need to have a training component. This is state mandated – will have to be done. Need to address issue of Out of Class – Lecture – is confusing. Can it be changed? Will check the mandate to see. Curriculum needs the feedback ASAP. Discussion: clarification needed of Out of class, lecture, how will we know what to put?
