

Resolution for Academic Senate support of the Veterans Center

WHEREAS: military veterans are a population at risk for academic, financial, medical and mental health challenges, and

WHEREAS, the Veterans Center was initially staffed with a faculty member, and

WHEREAS, previous success with the Veterans Center led to the college's recognition at a military friendly top ten school.

Therefore, be it RESOLVED, that the college continue its support for the Veterans Center program; complete with funding opportunities, resources, and other necessary support to preserve the Veterans Center role as a *learning center* as well as a resource center.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that administration respect the processes related to academic and professional matters, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the oversight of the Veterans Center rely primarily on the advice and recommendations of faculty.
