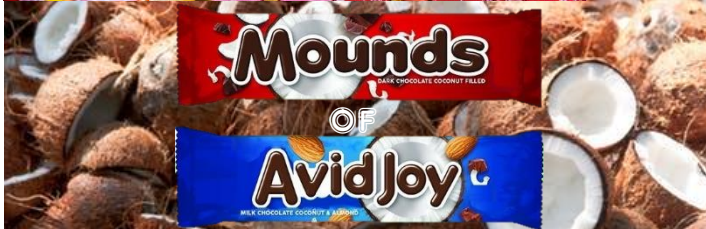


### Swimming with Starfish

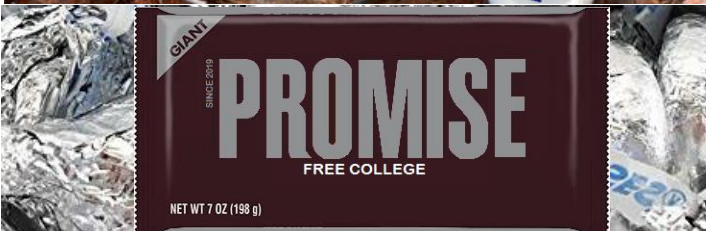


### AVID Student Support Strategies

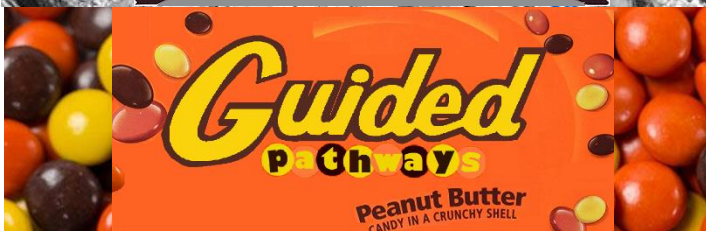


### College Promise Program
